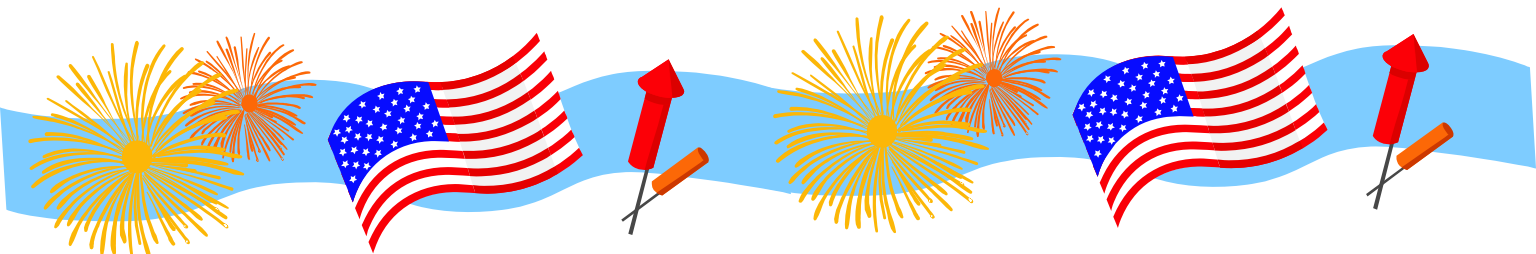

Speaker: Nancy Coey

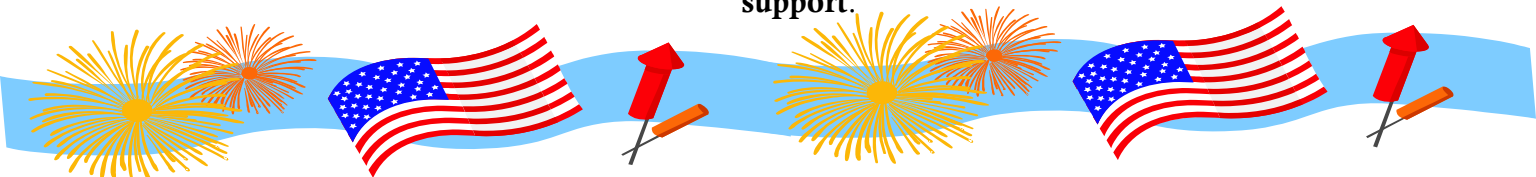
