If the refrigerator temperature falls out of the acceptable range of 34 to 40 degrees Fahrenheit (1.1 to 4.4 degrees Celsius) or the freezer temperature falls out of the acceptable range of 0 to -10 degrees Fahrenheit (-17.8 to -23.3 degrees Celsius), the unit secretary must be notified. The unit secretary will call Facilities and if there is a problem, Food Service is notified. While passing lunch trays, PFS representative will check temperature of refrigerator. If it has not recovered, then a Patient Services Manager will be contacted in order to make arrangements to move the food.

This record must be kept for one year and then destroyed per State requirement.
