

PROTOCOL FOR: Traffic Patterns for Permanent Pacemaker Insertion

POLICY: Refer to Protocol: Traffic Patterns

1. Traffic Patterns suggest movement into and out of the procedure suite as well as movement within the suite.
2. The procedure suite for permanent pacemaker insertion will be in the CCL C2131A.
3. The restricted area will be the procedure room. Clean scrub attire, hats and masks are required by all staff during the procedure. lead aprons are to be worn by all staff.
4. Patients entering the procedure suite should wear clean gowns, be covered with clean linens and have hair covered.
5. Keeping the sterile field away from the head of the procedure table until patient is draped will minimize possibility of contamination.
6. Talking and the number of people present in the procedure room should be minimized.
7. Phone X1048 will be rolled over to X1003.

CLINICAL ASSESSMENT AND

- CARE:
1. Upon admission to the procedure rooms, patient assessment will include identifying that he/she is wearing appropriate attire for the area.
  2. The flow of clean and soiled equipment will be monitored and maintained per protocol.
  3. Doors to the procedure room from the corridor and control room should be closed when procedure is in progress except during movement of patients, personnel, supplies, and equipment.
