

**PATIENTS RECEIVING IV CONTRAST
WHO TAKE MEDICATIONS
CONTAINING METFORMIN**

Bristol-Meyer Squibb Recommendation

Medications containing Metformin should be discontinued if the patient is going to be receiving IV contrast for a radiological study.

Metformin should be discontinued at the time of, or prior to, the procedure

Metformin should be withheld for 48 hours subsequent to the procedure and not reinstated until the patient's renal function is re-evaluated and found to be normal.
