**Generic Name: URSODIOL (Er-so-dye-all)**  
**Brand Name: ACTIGALL (Ac-ti-gall)**

#### **USE OF URSODIOL:**

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Ursodiol is used to improve the working of the liver and gall bladder so that your baby can digest and absorb food better.

#### **CALL THE DOCTOR IF:**

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1. Your baby vomits two regularly scheduled doses in a row.
2. Your baby spits up more than is usual for him/her or starts vomiting.
3. Your baby becomes irritable and fussy and cannot be calmed in the usual manner.
4. Your baby has diarrhea or becomes constipated.

#### **SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

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1. Review the 2 sections titled "**Safety**" and "**How to Use the Medicine**" in your **General Instructions for Giving Your Baby's Oral Medicine** hand out.
2. This medicine should not be given on an empty stomach. Put the correct dose in a half ounce (15 cc) of formula or breast milk in a bottle.
