Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT) evaluations and treatment.</li> <li>3. Crisis services for evaluations and treatment.</li> <li>4. Consultation and Liaison Services for evaluations and disposition planning.</li> </ol>
<b>Service Availability:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Adult Psychiatric Inpatient treatment 24 hours.</li> <li>2. Emergency/Crisis services are available through the Emergency Department as needed (24 hours/day).</li> <li>3. Consultation Liaison provided to Medical Services for evaluations and disposition planning.</li> </ol>
